In this Music Production Course, we will produce a song using Logic Pro DAW from start to finish learning all the steps necessary to make a radio-worthy track. We will learn the best sample libraries to use, how to design synth sounds, record your live instruments and vocals, mix and master your track with the right plug-ins so your music is ready to be distributed online, submitted to music production libraries and much more.

Jacob Friedman has been composing, educating and performing professionally since graduating Columbia University. He has received a certificate of recognition from the Carnegie Hall American Protege International Music Competition for excellence in teaching. He has scored the soundtracks for the Mysterious China documentary series by Monarex Hollywood and has had his pieces performed at Princeton University and at the Corcoran Gallery of Art, in Washington, D.C. As a songwriter, Jacob has released several albums spanning all genres from EDM to World music and collaborated with some notable writers including Peter Bliss, who produced for Barbra Streisand and NSYNC.

We will practice some advanced, though surprisingly simple, neurological techniques that will help to maximize and personalize a treatment plan custom designed for your body. The class is broken into very simple processes that will allow you to efficiently and effectively begin to understand the why behind the goofy exercises singers do! This helps with compliance and leads to better overall vocal results.

Amy Cutter has been a Licensed Massage Therapist for more than 20 years and is also a vocal performance coach. Music has been a huge passion for Amy her entire life. She has had recording studio experience and is uniquely comfortable on both sides of the studio and stage. She studied Musical Theatre at NY City's American Musical and Dramatic Academy (AMDA).
